the date of this letter that I have shifted

this time for the same but as circumstances
have prevented me from seeing you & settling up
the said obligation I hope you will write patiently
on me till the the month of January next & I
will be at your house in sabbot & pay you the
money and make all right with you for
nothing — I hope you will not make any
trouble for me write if you cant write
& I will see you as soon as possible
